

ELSIE SCHRADER GRANT-IN-AID EDUCATION PROGRAM

Provided by WFSE LOCAL 443

Instructions and Information---Please Read Carefully

ELIGIBILITY:

This scholarship is open to anybody in WFSE Local 443 who has been a member¹ for a consecutive period of at least 6 months immediately prior to application. As recipient, you must remain a WFSE member in good standing for the duration of the academic quarter.

Recipients must be enrolled in a registered vocational school or business school, an accredited community college, or an accredited two- or four-year college or university.

APPLICATION:

You must provide a completed application and proof of enrollment in person, electronically, or by US Mail to the Local 443 scholarship committee chairperson, or his/her representative.

Use the current application form adopted by the Scholarship Committee. This is available on the Local 443 Website at <http://www.wfselocal443.org/scholarships.php> Financial need will be a factor, and accurate financial information and proof of enrollment are mandatory for consideration.

You must submit this form, along with proof of enrollment within the first 30 days after the academic quarter begins.

REVIEW:

All grant requests shall be decided and acted upon by the committee. No request will be denied, except by a majority decision of the committee. The reason(s) for any such denial will be delivered in writing to the applicant.

The President of Local 443 appoints the Scholarship Committee Chairperson. Committee members are volunteers. The Treasurer of local 443 serves as an ex-officio member.

AWARD:

The maximum grant to any one individual shall not exceed \$500.00 per fiscal year(July 1-June 30).

All awards for approved grants will be disbursed by check.
