Instructions and Information – Read Carefully

1. The Washington Federation of State Employees, Olympia, Local 443, AFL-CIO offers two awards of \$500.00 each to be given annually on the basis of the following rules and information.
 - a. Applicant must be a graduating senior from an accredited public, private or parochial school in.
 - b. Applicant must be a child or ward of a Local 443 member.
 - c. Rules governing recipient award and use of funds,
 - (1) Must enroll in a college or university in the United States of his or her choice during the academic year.
 - (2) Paid to student upon presentation of the evidence of registration to the Local's treasurer.
2. WFSE will judge the applications based on the following criteria:
 - a. High school scholarship record and extra-curricular activities.
 - b. High school faculty evaluation
 - c. Demonstrated financial need
 - e. Personal interview if there is a tie
3. A complete application will have the following items:
 - a. Application forms completed by the student
 - b. Transcript of grades sent by the high school directly to the Scholarship Committee
 - c. A faculty member must complete, sign and forward the Faculty Comment Sheet directly to the Scholarship Committee.
 - d. The Scholarship Committee must receive all items listed in 3a to 3c above by May 1st of each year to be considered for the Scholarship.

No application will be considered without the Faculty Comment Sheet.
